っ - Small Tsu つ Hiragana Rules

The normal tsu つ, and the small tsu っ, which is smaller. You can notice this in hiragana in words like mittsu みっつ, "three," and in katakana in words like nattsu ナッツ you can create a double consonant (non-vowel) letter.

When reading out a word with a small つ you don't say the つ but instead leave a small pause or gap.




